Holy Spirit Teaching Lesson 6 Spiritual Gifts

Special Note: This Study is loosely based upon the book: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT by Hal Donaldson, Ken Horn, and Ann Floyd

TEXT: Mark 16:15-20 And he (*Jesus*) said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.

Luke 10:17-19 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

I Corinthians 12:27-30 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?

I Corinthians 12:4-7 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

Introduction: This is the continuation of the 5th & final lesson in our Holy Spirit Teaching Series: THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT. Since it is somewhat reedited. I will title it, "Lesson 6"

Again, I want us to spend a lot of time around the altar at the end of the service, Remember the goal I set which is to focus on a <u>"hands-on"</u> experience with God rather than an intelligential (class-room) study of facts and scripture proclamations.

I Corinthians 2:4-5 (*Apostle Paul*) And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

I. The Church needs "Special Power" to confront the REAL ISSUES of our life on earth! Everyday, we face Dangerous Powers and Pressing Issues. MANY OF THESE DAILY CONCERNS WILL NOT WAIT UNTIL WE ARE SAFELY IN HEAVEN – they must be DEALT with NOW!

OUR DENOMINATIONAL FRIENDS ARE SOLID IN THE WORD OF GOD AND DO MUCH GOOD – WE APPRECIATE THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ETERNAL WORK OF CHRIST - BUT - WE NEED HELP NOW!

The Church and the Followers of Christ must have <u>Direction and Help NOW</u> to Survive on Earth and be victorious in its mission!

ISSUES such as

- o A real and active devil
- o Unknown legions of demons and Spiritual Darkness in High Places

- o Real-time Illnesses and Diseases such as: Cancers, Heart Attacks, Heart Disease, Covid, Diabetes, High Blood Pressure, ETC.
- o Spiritual and Personal Direction for our Lives
- o Spiritual Direction for our churches
- Injured and Hurting People
- Discouragement
- o Miracles for Immediate Crisis confronting us: Financial, Family, Friends who come to us, ETC.
- o Death

II. The Gifts of the Spirit is GOD'S POWER POURED OUT upon BELIEVER TO ASSIST IN REAL-TIME ISSUES CONFRONTING US – TO HELP US become "MORE THAN CONQUERS"

Notice - God's Spiritual Gifts are not just <u>SPRINKLED</u> on a few "Superstar" Ministries. They are not given to be used to promote "Special" Ministers who are seeking the spotlight or a name for themselves - who seek personal glory - but not the glory of God!

The Gifts of the Spirit are for ALL to USE - all Operations, all Offices, all Ministries, all Believers within the Body of Christ

OUR TEXT: I Corinthians 12:27-30 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the church, **first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that** miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?

Ephesians 4:11 And <u>he gave</u> some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

9 DIFFERENT OFFICES AND OPERATIONS LISTED BELOW!

- Apostles DEFINITION one sent on a mission highest group of spiritual leaders within a church organization
- o **Prophets** NT PROPHETS **Acts** 11:27-28 And in these days came prophets from Jerusalem unto Antioch. And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.
 - Acts 21:10 And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.
 - Acts 13:1-2 Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain **prophets and teachers**; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.
- Evangelist NT EXAMPLE Acts 21:8-9 And the next day we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was one of the seven; and abode with him. And the same man had four daughters, virgins, which did prophesy.
- o Pastors / Teachers
- Workers of Miracles
- o Gifts of Healings
- Helps behind the scene support ministries who make the church function encourage greet backbone of the congregation – hold the congregation together by their faith - pray warriors, ETC.
- o Government Church Leadership such as Elders, Deacons, Women Leaders. ETC.
- o Diversities of Tongues

THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT ARE TO BE USED IN ALL AREAS OF THE WORK OF CHRIST: ALL MINISTRY/ OFFICES & by INDIVIDUAL BELIEVERS, AS THE HOLY SPIRIT DIRECTS!

III. Understanding the Gifts of the Spirit through the Works of Christ on Earth:

I Corinthians 12:8-10 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit. To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

Look at Jesus and his work on earth as an example to help us better understand the Gifts of the Spirit -- according to Scripture, JESUS did not use his own power as the Son of God in his work on earth. He used the power of the Holy Spirit – the same power we have available to use today as Christians!

Hebrews 2:16-18 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham. Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

Luke 4:18-21 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because <u>he hath anointed me</u> to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

IV. Gifts of the Spirit:

❖ Word of Wisdom – NOTICE - the <u>WORD of Wisdom</u> – **NOT Wisdom itself** *Example of Jesus using the WORD OF WISDOM* - NEVER A MAN SPAKE LIKE THIS MAN!

Mark 12:13-17 And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in his words. And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not? Shall we give, or shall we not give? But he, knowing their hypocrisy, said unto them, Why tempt ye me? bring me a penny, that I may see it. And they brought it. And he saith unto them, Whose is this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's. And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

Luke 21:13-15 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. And it shall turn to you for a testimony. Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.

- **❖ Word of Knowledge** NOTICE the <u>WORD of Knowledge</u> − **NOT human intellectual Knowledge** Example of Jesus using the WORD OF KNOWLEDGE
 - John 1:48-50 Nathanael saith unto him, Whence knowest thou me? Jesus answered and said unto him, Before that Philip called thee, when thou wast under the fig tree, I saw thee. Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel. Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, believest thou? thou shalt see greater things than these.
- ❖ Faith by the Spirit NOT our OWN personal faith –A SPECIAL HOLY SPIRIT IMPARTED FAITH An unshakeable trust in God to deliver on what He has promised -- NO MATTER WHAT! The Gift of Faith inspires others who may be tempted to give up - to hold on! The faith of Jesus was unshakable – Even on the Cross – Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit are ONE!

Psalms 22:1-5 My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? Why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring? O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them. They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded.

Psalms 22:22-25 I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee. Ye that fear the LORD, praise him; all ye the seed of Jacob, glorify him; and fear him, all ye the seed of Israel. For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard. My praise shall be of thee in the great congregation: I will pay my vows before them that fear him.

Example of Paul – **Gift of Imparted Faith** – Since the faith of Christ was unshakable – we must use Apostle Paul as our example for the Gift of Faith!

Acts 27:21-25 But after long abstinence Paul stood forth in the midst of them, and said, Sirs, ye should have hearkened unto me, and not have loosed from Crete, and to have gained this harm and loss. And now I exhort you to be of good cheer: for there shall be no loss of any man's life among you, but of the ship. For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve, Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee. Wherefore, sirs, be of good cheer: for I believe God, that it shall be even as it was told me.

❖ Gifts of Healings – this gift is self-explanatory

Example of Jesus using the GIFT OF HEALINGS

John 5:5-9 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole? The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me. Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk. And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked...

❖ Working of Miracles – this gift is self-explanatory

Example of Jesus using the GIFT OF MIRACLES

Luke 5:3-6 And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship. Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught. And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net. And when they had this done, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

❖ **Prophecy** – GIFT TO ENCOURAGE US OR WARN US OF COMING FUTURE EVENTS – Example of Jesus using the GIFT OF PROPHECY

Matthew 24:1-3 And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to show him the buildings of the temple. And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? Verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

❖ **Discerning of spirits** – NOTICE the LITTLE "s" in the word "spirits" –

I John 4 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Example of Jesus using the GIFT OF DISCERNMENT

John 8:41-44 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God. Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me. Why do ye not

understand my speech? Even because ye cannot hear my word. Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do...

❖ Tongues – HOLY SPIRIT STUDY LESSON 4 DEALT WITH THIS GIFT IN GREATER DETAILS! PERSONAL EDIFICATION – or – TO BE USED IN CONJUCTION WITH the INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

Words of Jesus on the Gift of Tongues

Mark 16:15-20 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.

❖ Interpretation of Tongues – HOLY SPIRIT STUDY LESSON 4 DEALT WITH THIS GIFT IN GREATER DETAILS!

I Corinthians 14 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.

I Corinthians 14:27-28 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.

I Corinthians 14:39-40 Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues. Let all things be done decently and in order.

VI. CLOSING: I must conclude my study with a biblical admonishment concerning Spiritual Gifts – COVET EARNESTLY THE BEST GIFTS BUT ALWAYS REMEMBER, WE MUST BE MOTIVATED BY LOVE AND COMPASSION!

Jesus was moved by compassion in all of his work on earth – we must be motivated by compassion and love as his disciples!

Matthew 9:35-38 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

I Corinthians 12:31 &13:1-3 31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet show I unto you a more excellent way. Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.
